ITINERARY :

Pick up from your hotel in Bangkok at **07:00 a.m.** Transfer to visit **Maeklong railway market** by private a/c vehicle. Explore the amazing market where you can see the train passing the market which the merchants selling their goods on the train track. Taste some traditional Thai desserts, fruits and drink at the market.

Then continue driving to the pier for your **private canal tour by long tail boat** (about 1 hour mins). Enjoy sightseeing on the boat tour, viewing the traditional Thai people house in the countryside as well as the local fruit and flower farms. The boat will bring you to visit **Damnoensaduak Floating Market**. Explore the first floating market in Thailand. Taste Thai desserts, fruits and drink and enjoy your personal time shopping at the market.

Continue driving about 1 hour to Ayutthaya. Have an optional lunch (late lunch) at the local restaurant. Visit **Wat Mahathat**, the royal temple in the center of Ayutthaya Historical park where you can see the head of Buddha image inside the tree root. Continue to visit **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, the ancient palace and royal chapel of Ayutthaya Kings from 1350-1782 A.D. Then transfer to visit **Wat Lokaya Sutharam**, the temple which has the longest reclining Buddha image in Ayutthaya. Return to your hotel in Bangkok.

ABOUT THE HIGHLIGHTS :



Maeklong Railway Market is the famous attraction in Samut Songkram province since February 1992. The location of the market is in the center of the city where the local people went there for shopping fresh food, mostly seafood.

The highlight of this market is to see the train passing the market which the merchants selling their food, seafood, desserts and vegetables on the train track.



Damnoensaduak Floating Market is the first floating market in Thailand which is famous for both local and tourists visit where you can see the merchants preserve their way of life selling the goods on the paddle boat.

In 1825, King Rama IV ordered to construct the Damnoensaduak Canal (17 km. or 10 miles) to connect with MaeKlong and Tha Chin rivers for transport. Then many floating markets arose from the canal and about 100 canals were dug by villagers for transport and use the water for farming.



Wat Lokaya Sutharam, the temple which built since the mid 15th century, located inside Ayutthaya Historical Park. The temple has the longest reclining Buddha image in Ayutthaya “Phra Buddha Saiyas”. It was constructed of bricks and cement in the art style of the Middle Ayutthaya Period and has 110 meters long and 8 meters high.

After the fall of Ayutthaya, The reclining Buddha image was restored in 1931. The Fine Arts department has continued to maintain it since then.
